Subject: Octavo Maltese Reading Scheme for Year 4, 5 and 6

The Qari ghal Qalbi reading scheme launched in November 2018, in conjunction with the EU co-funded One Tablet per Child project gives year 4, 5 and 6 students the possibility to read various Maltese ebook. Through the Qari ghal Qalbi library students can view their reading material, both online and offline. The reading is levelled according to the students' age and progression is enabled according to their abilities. This interactive application is dyslexia friendly and has an audio reading facility to enhance correct pronunciation of text. The students are presented with titles that are at par with their independent reading level, aiding vocabulary development whilst offering complete control over topics and title choice. Educators can make use of this scheme through the Octavo app where they can

- monitor student progress,
- set the <u>beginning of year quiz</u>,
- adjust student level and
- access the student mark view.
