Subject: SELFIE and Digital Citizenship Education (DCE) online session for Educators

The Directorate for Digital Literacy and Transversal Skills invites you to participate in an online session about SELFIE and Digital Citizenship Education on **Wednesday, 5th May, 2021 from 10:00am – 11:30am**. Educators attending this session are encouraged to have along with them a copy of their school's SDP and possibly any past SELFIE feedback report/s the school has in hand. These will be referred to during the workshop session.

During the third semester, SELFIE (Self-Reflection on Effective Learning by Fostering the use of Innovative Educational technologies) will be made accessible to all State and non-State Schools for students, educators and leaders till **Friday, 23th July, 2021**.

It is very important that every school participating in this reflective exercise appoints a SELFIE Coordinator to register the school, as well as to disseminate the link generated by the site to the participants. The **school's generic email** must always be supplied during registration. SELFIE will help schools to better know where they stand in the innovative use of digital tools in teaching and learning more so when these are included in the School's Development Plan (SDP).

Digital Citizenship Education (DCE) is intended to help young people to develop the competences required to engage and act as active participants in society through the use of digital technologies. Digital Citizenship Education is best conceived as a whole-school approach rather than a subject in the curriculum since it involves values and attitudes, not just technical skills and knowledge.

The information meeting intends to give an insight into the role of school communities in fostering DCE into their daily practices, not just to protect their students from the challenges of the digital world but to make them aware of how they can make best use of the digital technologies available.
