**Subject:** SELFIE Forum 2021: Empowering schools for learning in the digital age

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The Directorate for Digital Literacy and Transversal Skills (DDLTS) since 2018 has encouraging and supported schools to actively participate in SELFIE (Self-reflection on Effective Learning by Fostering the use of Innovative Educational technologies). Through this customizable tool schools are in a position to reflect where they stand with the use of digital technologies for teaching and learning in the digital age. In the last two and a half years Maltese schools have actively participated in SELFIE and sought ways to improve the use of digital technologies to better the quality of teaching and learning provision.

The European Commission through JRC-EAC, as the entity responsible for the running and the administration of SELFIE, is inviting schools that made use of the tool the opportunity to share their experiences. Schools are invited to participate by submitting a poster or short video of up to 3 minutes focused on a very specific topic which will portray the school experience with SELFIE. The idea is to provide useful information to other schools to develop their digital strategy and action plan.

The submission format should adhere to the following:

- Posters: (in PDF form) created with any software most accessible to the school or through the use of e-posters (<https://ltb.io/eposters/>). Please see attached flyer for access details.
- Videos: Not exceeding 3 minutes.

**Deadline for submissions: 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2021**
