**Subject: Family Coding 2021**

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Further to the success achieved in the past years, the Directorate for Digital Literacy and Transversal Skills will once again embark on the Family Coding initiative. The aim of the Family Coding initiative is to encourage parents and children to collaborate in order to solve a number of coding challenges while making creative use of the school tablet as part of the One Tablet per Child initiative. This year, Family Coding sessions will be held online and all participants will receive a link via email to attend the respective session.

Parents/guardians whose children are currently in Years 4, 5 and 6 are eligible to apply for the Family Coding sessions. During these sessions only one parent/guardian can attend. Students without an accompanying parent/guardian will not be allowed to participate in the activities. For every session, students need to avail themselves of the school tablet which needs to be fully charged. Please note that the same activities will be repeated with all the groups so each parent/guardian together with his/her child can only apply for one session.
