Subject: Invitation to attend an eTwinning European Face-to-Face Seminar in Malta
'Diverse & Creative Learning Environments'

The eTwinning National Support Organisation is inviting Maltese educators from primary and secondary state and non-state schools to participate in the eTwinning Malta-European Seminar for 2022.

Venue: Paradise Bay Hotel, Cirkewwa.

eTwinning Malta will also be hosting educators from around 14 countries across Europe.

Dates: 28- 29 – 30 April 2022

The seminar will commence at 16.00 on Thursday 28th April and conclude on Saturday 30th April at 16.00.

eTwinning Malta will be covering hotel accommodation throughout the seminar for Maltese educators. An eTwinning Introductory Pack will also be available for all.

The Seminar: Workshops will focus on introducing eTwinning, its tools, the eTwinning annual theme for 2022 (Diverse and creative learning environments) as well as digital literacy and the integration of eTwinning projects in schools. One of the sessions will also consist of a networking activity between participants aimed at encouraging registration of new eTwinning Collaborative Projects. A draft agenda is attached for your perusal.

Criteria

- Participation is strictly by application and on a first-come, first-served basis
- Educators who have attended similar eTwinning European face-to-face seminars in the last 3 years cannot apply.
- Educators are expected to have a project idea that will be developed during the seminar
- Interested educators must be registered within the eTwinning portal at www.etwinning.net
