

## Taking care of your tablet

- Your tablet should always be in its protective case.
- Always store your tablet facing down to avoid damaging the display.
- Do not place anything heavy on top of your tablet.
- Do not drop your tablet.
- Do not block holes or openings on your tablet.
- Do not leave the tablet in hot places or put it in direct sunlight.
- Do not charge it on carpets, rugs or beds.
- Avoid eating or drinking around your tablet.
- Turn off and shut down your tablet when you're not going to use it for a long time.
- To clean your tablet's display screen: wipe the screen surface gently using the soft cotton cloth provided with the tablet. Never clean the display with tissues or paper towels as they will scratch it.



## Accidental spills and breakages

- If the tablet gets wet, stop using it and let your teacher or parent know straight away.
  - If the tablet or its accessories break, stop using them and let your teacher or parent know.
- Caution: Your tablet is not waterproof.**

## Caring for Your Pen

- Use the stylus provided only to write or tap on the display.
- Do not tap heavily on the display.

## Caring for Your Headphones

- Do not pull on or twist the cord of the headphones.
- When removing headphones from your tablet always pull out the plug, not the cable.
- Always keep the headphones in their protective case.
